- 12. Then Jesus spoke out again, "I am the light of the world! The one who follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
- 25. So they said to him, "Who are you?"

Jesus replied, "What I have told you from the beginning. ²⁶I have many things to say and to judge about you, but the **Father** who sent me is **truthful**, and the things I have heard from him I speak to the world." ²⁷(They did not understand that he was telling them about his **Father**.)

- 28. Then Jesus said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and I do nothing on my own initiative, but I speak just what the **Father** taught me. ²⁹And the one who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, because I always do those things that please him."
- 30. While he was saying these things, many people believed in him.

The Truth sets God's Children free

- 31. Then Jesus said to those Judeans who had <u>believed him</u>, "If you <u>abide in my word</u> [continue to follow my teaching], you are really my disciples ³² and you will know the **truth**, and the **truth** will set you **free**."
- 33. "We are descendants of **Abraham**," they replied, "and have never been anyone's **slaves**! How can you say, 'You will become **free**'?"
- 34. Jesus answered them, "I tell you the solemn truth, everyone who practices sin is a **slave** of sin. ³⁵The **slave** does not remain in the family forever, but the son remains forever. ³⁶So if the son sets you **free**, you will be really **free**.
- 37. I know that you are **Abraham**'s descendants. But you want to kill me, because <u>my word has no</u> <u>place in you</u>. ³⁸I am telling you the things I have seen while with the **Father**; you practice the things you have heard from your **Father**!"
- 39. They answered him, "Abraham is our father!"

Jesus replied, "If you are **Abraham**'s children, you would be **doing the deeds of Abraham**,

40.

But now you are trying to kill me, a man who has told you the **truth** I heard from God. **Abraham** did not do this!

41. You people are **doing the deeds of** your **father**."

Then they said to Jesus, "We were not born as a result of immorality! We have only one **Father**, God himself."

- 42. Jesus replied, "If God were your **Father**, you would love me, for I have come from God and am now here. I have not come on my own initiative, but he sent me. ⁴³Why don't you understand what I am saying? It is because <u>you cannot accept my word</u>.
- 44. You people are from your father the devil, and you want to do what your father desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not uphold the truth, because there is no truth in him. Whenever he lies, he speaks according to his own nature, because he is a liar and the father of lies. ⁴⁵But because I am telling you the truth, you do not believe me. ⁴⁶Who among you can prove me guilty of any sin?

If I am telling you the **truth**, why don't you <u>believe me</u>? ⁴⁷The one who belongs to God <u>listens and responds</u> to God's words. You don't listen and respond, because you don't belong to God."

Before Abraham, "I am"

- 48. **The Judeans** replied, "Aren't we correct in saying that you are a Samaritan and are possessed by a demon?"
- 49. **Jesus** answered, "I am not possessed by a demon, but I honor my **Father**—and yet you dishonor me. ⁵⁰I am not trying to get praise for myself. There is one who demands it, and he also judges. ⁵¹I tell you the solemn truth, if anyone keeps my word [follows my teaching], he will never see death."
- 52. Then **the Judeans** responded, "Now we know you're possessed by a demon! Both **Abraham** and the prophets died, and yet you say, 'If anyone keeps my word, he will never experience death.' ⁵³You aren't greater than our father **Abraham** who died, are you? And the prophets died too! Who do you claim to be?"
- 54. **Jesus** replied, "If I glorify myself, my glory is worthless. The one who glorifies me is my **Father**, about whom you people say, 'He is our God.' ⁵⁵Yet you do not know him, but I know him. If I were to say that I do not know him, I would be a liar like you. But I do know him, and I keep his word. ⁵⁶Your father **Abraham** was overjoyed to see my day, and he saw it and was glad."
- 57. Then the Judeans replied, "You are not yet fifty years old! Have you seen Abraham?"
- 58. Jesus said to them, "I tell you the solemn truth, before Abraham came into existence, I am!"
- 59. Then they picked up stones to throw at him,

but **Jesus was hidden** from them and went out from the temple area.
