- 4. as he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and blameless before him in love.
- 5. **having predestined us** to sonship through Jesus Christ to himself, **according to the pleasure of his will,**
- 6. **to the praise of the glory of his grace** which he heaped graciously on us in the Beloved One,
- 7. in whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of transgressions, according to the riches of his grace,

2. Present

- 8. that he lavished on us in all wisdom and insight,
- having revealed to us the mystery of his will, according to his pleasure that he purposed in him,
- 10. as a plan for the fullness of the times, to bring together under one head all things in Christ, the things in heaven and things on earth in him.

3. Future

- 11. in whom we have also received an inheritance,
 - having been predestined according to the purpose of the one who is working in all things according to the council of his will,
- so that we might be to the praise of his glory who first put our hope in Christ,
- in whom you also, having heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, in whom you then believed, were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
- 14. who is the first deposit of our inheritance, until the redemption of the possession,

to the praise of his glory.
