- 8. For by grace <u>you have been saved</u>, through faith and this is **not from** yourselves; it is God's gift
- 9. **not from** works, so that no one can boast.
- 10. For <u>we are</u> his workmanship, created <u>in Christ Jesus</u> for <u>good works</u> which God prepared ahead of time that <u>we should walk</u> in them.
