The Seven Walks in Ephesians

Eph 2:2

- 1. And you were dead in your trespasses and sins
- 2. <u>in which you once walked</u>

Eph 2:10

10. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works which God prepared ahead of time that we should walk in them.

Eph 4:1

1. I therefore appeal to you, as the prisoner of the Lord to walk worthy of the calling you've been called into

Eph 4:17

17. This therefore I say
And I insist in the Lord
that you must **no longer walk as the Gentiles walk**

Eph 5:2

- 1. Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children.
- 2. And walk in love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God for a fragrant aroma.

Eph 5:8

- 7. Therefore do not become fellow sharers with them;
- 8. for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord.

Walk as children of light

Eph 5:15

15. Watch carefully then how you walk,

not as unwise but as wise,

Ephesians 5:1-6

- 1. Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children.
- And <u>walk</u> in love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God for a fragrant aroma.
- 3. But **sexual immorality** and all **impurity** or **covetousness** must not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints.
- 4. Let there be no **filthiness** nor **foolish talk** nor **giving of sarcastic ridicule**, which are out of place, but instead let there be giving of thanks.
- 5. For you may be sure of this, that everyone who is **sexually immoral** or **impure**, or who is **covetous** (therefore an idolater), has no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.
- Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.
