Ephesians 6:10–20 – Putting on the Armour of God

- 10. Finally, be **empowered** in the Lord and in his **mighty strength**.
- 11. Put on the full armor of God

that you may have the power to stand against the schemes of the devil.

12. For our struggle is not **against** blood and flesh

but <u>against</u> the rulers

<u>against</u> the authorities

<u>against</u> the world powers over this darkness

<u>against</u> the evil spiritual beings in the heavenly places.

13. Because of this take up the complete armor of God that you may have the power to withstand on the evil day and having prepared in every way, to stand.

- 14. Stand then
 - 1. by strapping truth around your waist
 - 2. by putting on the breastplate of righteousness
- 15. 3. by putting onto your feet: the readiness to give the gospel of peace.
- 16. 4. by taking up, in all situations, the shield of faith with which you will have power to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one
- 17. **5.** by receiving the **helmet** of **salvation**
 - **6.** by taking up the **swo**rd of the **Spirit**, which is the word of God
- 18. **7.** by praying with every prayer and petition at all times in the **Spirit**, ___

watching for this purpose with all perseverance and making requests for all the saints,

- 19. and also on behalf of me: that words may be given to me so that whenever I open my mouth with boldness I'll make known the mystery of the gospel
- 20. on behalf of which I am an ambassador in chains: that I might be bold, as I should speak.
