Philippians 3:1-4:1

- Finally, my brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord!

 To write this again is no trouble to me, and it is a safeguard for you.
- 2 Look out for the dogs, look out for the evildoers, look out for those who mutilate the flesh.

flesh/spirit — old creation values vs new creation life

3 For we are the <u>circumcision</u>,

who worship by the Spirit of God,

and glory in Christ Jesus,

and put no confidence in the flesh,

4 though I also might have confidence in the flesh.

If anyone else thinks he has reason for **confidence in the flesh**, I have more:

- 5 circumcised on the eighth day,
 - of the people of Israel,
 - of the tribe of Benjamin,
 - a Hebrew of the Hebrews;
 - regarding the law, a Pharisee;
- 6 regarding zeal, persecuting the church;
 - regarding righteousness under the law, blameless.

gain/loss — righteousness from law/faith — death/resurrection

- 7 But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ.
- Indeed, I **count everything as loss** because of the far greater value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have **suffered the loss of all things**—I even regard them as **dung**!

that I may gain Christ

- 9 and be found in him,
 - not because I have my own righteousness derived from the law,

but that which comes through Christ's faithfulness,

the righteousness from God that depends on faith;

My aim is to know him

and the power of his resurrection,

and to share in his sufferings,

becoming like him in his death,

and so, by what ever means, to attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Not that I have <u>already attained</u>, or am <u>already perfected</u>;

but I press on, to lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

Brothers and sisters, I do not count myself to have attained this, but I am single-minded, forgetting those things which are behind

and reaching forward to those things which are ahead,

I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

the mature mind

15 Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind;

and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that to you also.

16 Only let us walk by the standard that we have already attained.

walk of example/walk of wickedness — earthly mind/heavenly mind

- 17 Be imitators of me, brothers and sisters, and watch carefully those who are <u>walking</u> this way, just as you have us as an example.
- 18 For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even with tears,

that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:

19 whose end is destruction,

whose god is their belly,

and whose glory is in their shame

-who set their mind on earthly things.

But our citizenship is in heaven,

from where we also eagerly wait for the Savour, the Lord Jesus Christ,

21 who will transform our lowly body to become like his glorious body,

according to the power by which he is able even to subject all things to himself.

4:1 Therefore, my beloved and longed-for brothers and sisters, my joy and crown, **stand firm** in the Lord in this way, my beloved.
