Romans 8: No Condemnation

1	There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
2	For the law of the Spirit of life
	has set you free in Christ Jesus
	from the law of sin and death.
3	For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do.
	By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful <u>flesh</u> and for sin,
4	he condemned sin in <u>the flesh</u> , in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us,
4	
	those who walk
	not according to the flesh
	but according to <u>the Spirit</u> .
5	For those who live according to the flesh
	have the way of thinking of the flesh,
	<i>but</i> those who live according to <u>the Spirit</u>
	have the way of thinking of the Spirit.
6	For the way of thinking of <u>the flesh</u> is death,
	but the way of thinking of the Spirit is life and peace.
7	Because the way of thinking of the flesh is hostile to God,
	For it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot.
8	Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.
9	You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit,
	if in fact <u>the Spirit</u> of God dwells in you.
	But if Anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ,
	he does not belong to him.
10	But if Christ is in you,
	although the body is dead because of sin,
	the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
11	But if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you,
	he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead
	will also give life to your <u>mortal bodies</u>
	through <u>his Spirit</u> who dwells in you.
12	So then, brothers, we have an obligation,
13	not to <u>the flesh</u> , to live according to <u>the flesh</u> .
15	For if
	you live according to <u>the flesh</u>
	you are certain to die,
	But if by the Spirit
	you put to death
	the practices of <u>the body</u> , you will live.
	you will not.

31 What then shall we say to these things?

- If God is for us, who can be against us?
- 32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all,
 - how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?
- 33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?
- It is God who justifies. 34 *Who is to condemn?*
- Christ Jesus is the one
 - who **died**—more than that,
 - who was **raised**
 - who is at the right hand of God,
 - who indeed is interceding for us.
- 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?
 - Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?
- 36 As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."
- 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors
- through him who loved us.
- 38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers,
- 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
