- Mat 3:11"I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will **baptize** you with the **Holy Spirit** and with fire.
- Mat 3:16 And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the **Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him**;
- Mat 12:18 "Behold, my servant whom I have chosen, my beloved with whom my soul is well pleased. I will **put my Spirit upon him**, and he will proclaim justice to the Gentiles.
- Mat 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- Mar I:8 I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."
- Mar 1:10 And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens opening and the **Spirit descending on him** like a dove.
- Luk 1:15 for he will be great before the Lord. And he must not drink wine or strong drink, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb.
- Luk 1:17 and he will go before him **in the spirit and power of Elijah**, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready for the Lord a people prepared."
- Luk 1:35 And the angel answered her, "**The Holy Spirit will come upon** you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy-the Son of God.
- Luk 1:41 And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the baby leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit,
- Luk 1:67 And his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied, saying,
- Luk 2:25 Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and **the Holy Spirit was upon him**.
- Luk 2:27 And he came **in the Spirit** into the temple, and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him according to the custom of the Law,
- Luk 3:16 John answered them all, saying, "I baptize you with water, but he who is mightier than I is coming, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.
- Luk 3:22 and **the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form, like a dove**; and a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."
- Luk 4:1 And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness
- Luk 4:14 And Jesus **returned in the power of the Spirit** to Galilee, and a report about him went out through all the surrounding country.
- Luk 4:18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed,
- Luk 11:13 If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father **give**[didomi] the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"
- Joh 1:32 And John bore witness: "I saw the Spirit descend from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him.
- Joh 1:33 I myself did not know him, but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.'
- Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is **born of water and the Spirit**, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.
- Joh 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- Joh 3:8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is **born of the Spirit**."
- Joh 3:34 For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for he gives didomi the Spirit without measure.
- Joh 7:39 Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive [lambano], for as yet the Spirit had not been [given], because Jesus was not yet glorified.

- Joh 14:17 even **the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive**, [lambano] because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he <u>dwells with you and will be in you</u>.
- Joh 14:26 But the Helper, **the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name**, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.
- Joh 15:26 "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.
- Joh 16:13 When **the Spirit of truth comes**, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.
- Joh 20:22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive [lambano] the Holy Spirit.
- Act 1:2 until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen.
- Act 1:5 for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."
- Act 1:8 But you will receive [lambano] power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
- Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- Act 2:17 "And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams;
- Act 2:18 even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy.
- Act 2:33 Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received [lambano] from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing.
- Act 2:38 And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive [lambano] the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Act 4:8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders,
- Act 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and **they were all filled** with **the Holy Spirit** and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.
- Act 5:32 And we are witnesses to these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given [didomi] to those who obey
- Act 6:3 Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, **full** of the **Spirit** and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty.
- Act 6:5 And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man **full** of **faith and of the Holy Spirit**, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch.
- Act 7:55 But he, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.
- Act 8:15 who came down and prayed for them that they might receive [lambano] the Holy Spirit,
- Act 8:17 Then they laid their hands on them and they received [lambano] the Holy Spirit.
- Act 8:18 Now when Simon saw that **the Spirit was given** [didomi] **through the laying on of the apostles' hands**, he offered them money,
- Act 8:19 saying, "Give me this power also, so that anyone on whom I lay my hands may receive [lambano] the Holy Spirit."
- Act 9:17 So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."
- Act 10:38 how **God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power**. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.
- Act 10:44 While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word.
- Act 10:45 And the believers from among the circumcised who had come with Peter were amazed, because **the gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out even on the Gentiles**.
- Act 10:47 "Can anyone withhold water for baptizing these people, who have received [lambano] the Holy Spirit just as we have?"
- Act 11:15 As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them just as on us at the beginning.
- Act 11:16 And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, 'John baptized with water, but **you will be baptized** with the **Holy Spirit**.'

- Act 11:24 for he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord.
- Act 13:9 But Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked intently at him
- Act 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.
- Act 15:8 And God, who knows the heart, bore witness to them, by giving didoni them the Holy Spirit just as he did to us,
- Act 19:2 And he said to them, "Did you receive [lambano] the Holy Spirit when you believed?" And they said, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit."
- Act 19:6 And when **Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them**, and they began speaking in tongues and prophesying.
- Rom 5:5 and hope does not put us to shame, because **God's love has been poured into our hearts** through the Holy Spirit who has been given [didomi] to us.
- Rom 7:6 But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve not under the old written code but in the **new life of the Spirit**.
- Rom 8:4 in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
- Rom 8:5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who **live according to the Spirit** set their minds on the things of the Spirit.
- Rom 8:9 You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God <u>dwells in you</u>. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.
- Rom 8:10 But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
- Rom 8:11 If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.
- Rom 8:12 So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh.
- Rom 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if **by the Spirit** you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.
- Rom 8:14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.
- Rom 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received [lambano] the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"
- Rom 8:16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,
- Rom 8:23 And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.
- Rom 8:26 Likewise **the Spirit helps us in our weakness**. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us **with groanings too deep for words**.
- Rom 8:27 And he who searches hearts knows what is the **mind of the Spirit**, because **the Spirit** intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.
- Rom 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.
- Rom 15:19 by the power of signs and wonders, by **the power of the Spirit of God**--so that from Jerusalem and all the way around to Illyricum I have fulfilled the ministry of the gospel of Christ;
- ICo 2:4 and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in **demonstration of the Spirit and of power**,
- ICo 2:12 Now we have **received** [lambano] **not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God**, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.
- ICo 3:16 Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?
- And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.
- ICo 6:17 But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.
- ICo 6:19 Or do you not know that **your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God**? You are not your own,
- ICo 7:40 Yet in my judgment she is happier if she remains as she is. And I think that I too have the Spirit of God.

- ICo 12:3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one **speaking in the Spirit of God** ever says "Jesus is accursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit.
- ICo 12:7 To each is given [didomi] the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
- ICo 12:8 **To one is given** [didomi] through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit,
- ICo 12:9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,
- ICo 12:10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
- ICo 12:11 All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.
- ICo 12:12 For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ.
- ICo 12:13 For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body--jews or Greeks, slaves or free--and all were made to drink of one Spirit.
- ICo 15:45 Thus it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being"; the last Adam became a life-giving spirit.
- 2Co 1:22 and who has also put his seal on us and given us [didomi] his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.
- 2Co 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.
- 2Co 3:18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For **this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit**.
- 2Co 5:5 He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us [didomi] the Spirit as a guarantee.
- 2Co 11:4 For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus than the one we proclaimed, or **if you receive** [lambano] **a different spirit from the one you received**, [lambano] or if you accept a different gospel from the one you accepted, you put up with it readily enough.
- 2Co 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
- Gal 3:2 Let me ask you only this: Did you receive [lambano] the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?
- Gal 3:3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?
- Gal 3:4 Did you suffer so many things in vain--if indeed it was in vain?
- Gal 3:5 Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith--
- Gal 3:14 so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive [lambano] the promised Spirit through faith.
- Gal 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"
- Gal 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.
- Gal 5:17 For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the **desires of the Spirit are against the flesh**, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.
- Gal 5:18 But if you are **led by the Spirit**, you are not under the law.
- Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- Gal 5:25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.
- Eph 1:13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,
- Eph 1:17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give [didomi] you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him,
- Eph 2:18 For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.
- Eph 2:22 In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.
- Eph 3:16 that according to the riches of his glory he may grant [didomi] you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being,
- Eph 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- Eph 5:18 And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit,
- Eph 6:18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,
- Php 1:19 for I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance,

- 1Th 1:5 because **our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit** and with full conviction. You know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.
- ITh I:6 And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit,
- ITh 4:8 Therefore whoever disregards this, disregards not man but God, who gives [didomi] his Holy Spirit to you.
- 1Th 5:19 **Do not quench the Spirit**.
- 2Th 2:13 But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through **sanctification by the Spirit** and belief in the truth.
- 2Ti 1:7 for God gave [didomi] us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.
- 2Ti 1:14 By the Holy Spirit who dwells within us, guard the good deposit entrusted to you.
- Tit 3:5 he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit,
- Heb 2:4 while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and various miracles and by **gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed** according to his will.
- Heb 6:4 For it is impossible to restore again to repentance those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have **shared in the Holy Spirit**,
- IPe I:2 according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in **the sanctification of the Spirit**, for obedience to Jesus Christ and for sprinkling with his blood: May grace and peace be multiplied to you.
- IPe I:II inquiring what person or time **the Spirit of Christ in them** was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories.
- IPe 1:12 It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.
- IPe 1:22 Having purified your souls by **your obedience to the truth through the Spirit** for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart,
- IPe 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but **made alive in the spirit**,
- IPe 4:14 If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.
- 2Pe 1:21 For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.
- IJn 3:24 Whoever keeps his commandments abides in him, and he in them. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given didomi us.
- IJn 4:2 By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God.
- In 4:13 By this we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given [didomi] us of his Spirit.
- IJn 5:6 This is he who came by water and blood--Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.
- Jud 1:19 It is these who cause divisions, worldly people, devoid of the Spirit.
- Jud 1:20 But you, beloved, build yourselves up in your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit;
- Rev 1:101 was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet
- Rev 4:2 At once I was in the Spirit, and behold, a throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the throne.
- Rev 17:3 And he carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness, and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was full of blasphemous names, and it had seven heads and ten horns.
- Rev 19:10 Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God." For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
- Rev 21:10 And **he carried me away in the Spirit** to a great, high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God,
