Pride

Proverbs 16:18

18. Pride goes before destruction,
And a haughty spirit before a fall.

Matthew 11:28-30

28. "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
29. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
30. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Dependent on God's Power: Eph 3:20

20. Now to him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us

Obedient to God's Word: Josh 1:8-9

8. This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
9. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

15. For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.

Humble Exalted

Matthew 23:12

12. And whoever exalts himself will be humbled,
and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

Luke 14:11

11. For whoever exalts himself will be humbled,
and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

1 Peter 5:5-7

5. ...and be clothed with humility, for
"God resists the proud,
But gives grace to the humble."
6. Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty
hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time,
7. casting all your care upon him, for he cares for you.

Philippians 2:3-11

3. Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.
4Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.
5. Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, ⁷but made himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. ⁸And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
⁹Therefore God also has highly exalted him and given him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Isaiah 26:3

3. Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Mark 10: 43-45

43. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant.
44. And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all.
45. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many."

Pharisee & Tax Collector: Luke 18:9-14

9. Also he spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:
10. "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector.
11. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank you that I am not like other men—extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax collector. ¹²I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess.'
13. And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!'
14. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."
